APPLICATION REQUIREMENTS

In order to be able to participate in the activity, students must first meet the following minimum requirements:

- 1- The student must be a **full-time student** enrolled in a higher education program in any of the stages of education (first, second or third cycle),
- 2- a) The cumulative academic grade average of first cycle students must be at least **2.20 / 4.00**,
b) The cumulative academic grade average of the second and third cycle students must be at least **2.50 / 4.00**.
- 3- Students must have sufficient number of ECTS credits for learning mobility (60 ECTS credits for one academic year).

DOCUMENTS REQUIRED FOR APPLICATION

- Erasmus Application Form
- Copy of ID Card,
- Transcript
- Copy of passport ID page
- 2 passport size photos
- Photocopy of Foreign Language Exam Result Document (if the student has taken a national/international exam before)

Applications will be completed and handed over to the International Relations Office. Missing applications are strictly not accepted.

Students with AHEP exam results do not need to submit a foreign language examination result document. Other students must include exam results in the application file.

EVALUATION OF FOREIGN LANGUAGE EXAM AND PASSING SCORE

The exam carried out by the School of Foreign Languages of Alanya HEP University will take place in two stages.

1st section: Written exam (80% of the total grade)

2nd section: Speaking exam (20% of the total grade)

According to the results of both stages, students who pass the point barrage presented below will be evaluated.

Passing Score for Foreign Language Exam

For Erasmus + Studies Mobility: **60/100**

For Erasmus +Traineeship Mobility: **60/100**

<i>Martyr and veteran children</i>	+15 points
<i>Students with disabilities (with documentation of your disability)</i>	+10 points
<i>Students who have received protection, care or compensation decision within the scope of Social Services Act No. 2828</i>	+10 points
<i>Earlier utilization (with/without grant)</i>	-10 points
<i>Participating in mobility in a citizen's country</i>	-10 points
<i>Students who had been elected for mobility and did not join the mobility without a disclaimer notice (if the student applies for Erasmus again)</i>	-10 points
<i>Students who apply for two types of mobility at the same time (Reduction is applied to the type of activity preferred by the student)</i>	-10 points
<i>For students elected to the mobility: Not participating in the meetings / trainings organized by the higher education institution in relation to mobility (if the student applies for Erasmus again)</i>	-5 points
<i>Students who declare to take the language exam but do not take it without any excuse (if the student applies for Erasmus again)</i>	-5 points

GRANT AMOUNTS

The Erasmus grant is the financial support provided to the students who go abroad in the scope of the Erasmus+ Programme in a way that they will not be asked to pay back as long as they have fulfilled their Erasmus+ obligations.

The National Agency determines monthly Erasmus+ grant amounts separately for each group of countries according to living standards.

The grant is intended to support educational activities and does not cover all expenses of the student.

IMPORTANT NOTES

- It is possible to benefit from the program of Erasmus + Student Studies and Traineeships mobility programme with or without gratitude.
- The fact that the student retakes a failed course does not prevent students from applying Erasmus +.
- There is no obligation to have an Erasmus + bilateral agreement on the departments where students want to take advantage of the Erasmus+ Traineeship Mobility programme. The exam can be applied only by selecting the traineeship option.
- Each student can benefit from a maximum of 12 months of learning and / or traineeship activity with or without grants, including the duration of the activity he / she has previously used in each level of education (undergraduate, graduate, doctorate) under Erasmus+.
- Students who have been selected for mobility but wish to waive it are required to notify the International Relations Office within 10 working days after the result announcement so that no point reduction is applied on their next application.
- Students studying in double major can apply for mobility from only one major in the same application period.
