

OUR UNIVERSITY'S DECISIONS REGARDING THE SPRING SEMESTER 2022-2023

Dear students,

It has been decided by The Council of Higher Education to start the 2022-2023 academic year spring term as distance education. In order to continue our education activities without interruption, our University Senate hereby has decided for:

- 1) The starting date to be set as 2022-2023 spring term as February 27th, 2023,
- 2) All undergraduate, graduate, post-graduate and School of Foreign Languages programs to continue their educational activities as **distance learning (online)** according to the hours stated on their weekly schedule.
- 3) The course registration to end on February 28th, and the add-drop processes to continue until March 31st, 2023.
- 4) The students who meet both requirements (a) and (b) stated below to benefit from the status of being a special student:
 - a. Being a registered student at the universities in the provinces affected by the earthquake or having first-degree relatives living in the provinces in the earthquake zone and being a registered student at the universities in the provinces outside the earthquake zone.
 - b. To be a registered student in the programs (students specified in Article 5) within the scope of the "Framework Regulation for Applied Education in Higher Education".
- 5) Since students who want to benefit from the special student status must apply to the university they want to be a special student in, special student applications must be made within 3 weeks from the Spring Semester education start date of the university to which they will apply (the application deadline to our university is March 24th, 2023),
- 6) Every student who requests can freeze their registration for the Spring Semester, to be able to apply for a registration freeze within 3 weeks from the start of the Spring Semester (deadline application date is March 24th, 2023), the semester in which the student freezes registration not to be counted within the maximum time of education, the registration freeze requests which haven't been made within the specified time because of the excuses of the students to be re-considered by the authorized committees of our University if they apply by documenting their excuse, and also exemption from the registration freeze fee of our earthquake-affected students,
- 7) The 2022-2023 academic year spring term academic calendar to be updated as of February 27th, 2023,
- 8) The procedures and principles regarding how the midterm and final exams will be held, and the blended (hybrid) teaching methods related to distance education in April, to be evaluated in line with the statements to be made by the Council of Higher Education.
