2023-2024 Academic Year Beginning of the Year English Proficiency Exam will be held **face to face** on **September 25-26, 2023 in 3 sessions in 2 days.**

- > <u>Speaking sessions</u> will be held **on September 26, 2023.**

Students who want to take the exam **must fill in the pre-registration form** until the end of working hours **on 19.09.2023** and declare that they will attend the exam (<u>Click here</u> for the form).

For students who enroll in our university with YKS and will continue to the English Preparatory Program according to the Proficiency Exam results, an ENGLISH PLACEMENT EXAM will be held in class 112 in different sessions between the dates 02-03.10.2023. The session in which the students will take the exam will be announced on the website of our university on Monday, 02.10.2023.

Students who will take the exam must be in the exam hall **15 minutes before their session starts**, together with their **ID cards**.

Since there is listening and speaking sections in the exam, students are required to **bring their own** headsets as part of hygiene measures.
