

#### **APPLICATION DOCUMENTS:**

All documents must be prepared in **Turkish** or **English**. If prepared in other languages, approved copies in Turkish must also be attached to the original documents. Only translations approved by a notary or Foreign Turkish Representative will be accepted.

- 1. High School Diploma or Temporary Graduation Certificate
- 2. Transcript: Transcript showing all courses taken and grades achieved in high school
- 3. If any, the official certificate showing the result of the exam taken at the end of high school education (such as Abitur, International Baccalaureate, GCE, Tawjihi, etc.)
- 4. Copy of the pages from the **passport** that have photograph and identity information. (Turkish or English translations are required for languages other than Turkish or English)
- 5. **Bank receipt** confirming that <u>30 USD application fee</u> is deposited in Alanya University USD Ziraat Bank account. <u>The name and the passport number of the applicant must be written</u> on the receipt. All transaction costs are covered by the applicant. Account information:

## ADMISSION OF INTERNATIONAL STUDENTS TO ASSOCIATE DEGREES AND UNDERGRADUATE PROGRAMMES AT ALANYA UNIVERSITY

#### **IN THE ACADEMIC YEAR 2025-2026**

Alanya University examines each application one by one, separately. If the student is accepted, Alanya University sends an acceptance letter to the student.

If admitted students do not have a valid **residence permit**, they need an **education visa** issued by the nearest Turkish Embassy/Consulate located either in the country of residence or in the nearest country in order to enter Turkey. They may apply for the education visa with the official acceptance letter sent by Alanya University.



#### **DOCUMENTS REQUIRED FOR ENROLMENT:**

- 1. **High school diploma** in Turkish (**Temporary graduation certificate** will be accepted in case of the newly graduate students whose high school diploma has not been issued yet.)
- 2. **Equivalency Certificate** (Certificate of Equivalence can be obtained from the Turkish consulates or the Provincial Directorate of National Education https://edenklik.meb.gov.tr/)
- 3. **High school transcript** approved by high school authorities (in Turkish)
- 4. **Original Passport** (Turkish or English translations are required for languages other than Turkish or English)
- 5. If any, the official certificate showing the result of the **exam taken at the end of high school** education (such as Abitur, International Baccalaureate, GCE, Tawjihi, etc.)
- 6. If any, the official result of a **university entrance exam** taken in the last two years (e.g. SAT, YÖS, etc.)
- 7. If any, an official **English Language Exam Certificate** with the test results (TOEFL, FCE, CAE, Pearson's PTE, CPE)
- 8. Residence Permit or Student Visa
- 9. Health Insurance
- 10. Bank receipt proving the payment of school fees
- 11. **4 recent photographs** sized 4,5x6,0
- 12. A document proving that the financial situation of the student is sufficient enough to continue higher education in Turkey (minimum the amount of one-year tuition fee)

#### LANGUAGE OF INSTRUCTION:

### The language of education is 100% English for the programs which are in English and 100% Turkish for the programs which are in Turkish.

- There is one year intensive English education at the English Preparatory Programme, which is not included in the four-year study period.
- Turkish Proficiency: for students who enrol in programs whose language of education is Turkish, in order to start their education in the department, they must have a Turkish Proficiency Certificate issued by official institutions and organizations of the State of the Republic of Turkey and universities (TÖMER C1). Students who do not have a certificate are allowed for a period of one year to obtain a Turkish Proficiency Certificate. At the end of this period, registration of the student who does not submit a document will be cancelled automatically.



 A Turkish Proficiency Certificate is not required from students who have completed their entire high school education at a Turkish high school abroad or at a high school in Turkey and graduated.

Those who pass the English Proficiency Exam at the beginning of the academic year or who pass any of the following exams (<u>obtained within last two years</u>) can directly start their studies in the faculties.

Those who have completed their high school education at an English medium school in an English spoken country together with the country citizens will also be exempted from English Preparatory School if they submit a document providing their education was in English. The applications of these students are examined by the SFL Directorate and the results of the students who are found to meet the requirements are forwarded to directorate of student affairs by the SFL.

Those students who fail the Proficiency Test take a one-year intensive English education and retake the test at the end of the academic year. Successful students will be able to register for their department.
