

2025-2026 ACADEMIC YEAR RUSSIAN I-II (RUSSIAN 1&2) EXEMPTION EXAM ANNOUNCEMENT

During the Fall Semester of the 2025-2026 Academic Year, a Russian Exemption Exam will be administered for students who have selected the elective foreign language courses offered under the School of Foreign Languages, Modern Languages Unit, namely RUS 101 (Russian I) and RUS 102 (Russian II) or RUS 301 (Russian I) and RUS 302 (Russian II), or those who have previously failed these courses.

The exemption exam for RUS 101 (Russian I) and RUS 102 (Russian II) or RUS 301 (Russian I) and RUS 302 (Russian II) courses, offered by the Modern Languages Unit, will be held on Thursday, September 25, 2025, at 17:00 on the Main Campus.

- The exam will be administered face-to-face between **17:00 18:00** on the Main Campus.
- Students who wish to take the exam must complete the pre-registration form to confirm their participation (<u>CLICK HERE</u> for the pre-registration form).

- Students taking the exam must be present in the exam hall with their ID cards no later than **16:45.**
