

## 1. Online Application

International students applying to **associate degree and undergraduate programs** at Alanya University must complete the **online application form** and upload all required documents through the official application system:

All applications are reviewed **individually and independently**. Applicants who meet the admission criteria will receive an **Official Letter of Acceptance** issued by Alanya University.

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## 2. Application Fee (USD 30)

Applicants are required to pay a **non-refundable application fee of 30 USD** prior to submitting the online application.

### Important payment instruction:

The **student's full name (exactly as written in the passport)** must be clearly stated in the **description / explanation section** of the bank transfer.

All bank transfer and transaction fees are the responsibility of the applicant.

A copy of the **bank receipt confirming the application fee payment** must be uploaded to the online application system.

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## 3. Student Visa & Residence Permit

Applicants who **do not hold a valid Turkish residence permit** must obtain a **student visa** from the nearest Turkish Embassy or Consulate using the official acceptance letter.

### Visa-Free Entry Information

Citizens of certain countries may enter Türkiye **without a visa for a limited number of days** under visa-exemption agreements.

**Visa-free entry does not replace a student residence permit.** All international students must apply for a **student residence permit after arrival** in Türkiye to continue their studies legally.

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## 4. Document Authentication & Translation Requirements

- **High school diplomas must be apostilled in the applicant's home country.**
- All required documents, **including the passport**, must be **officially translated into Turkish.**

### Important Notes on Translation and Notarization

- If translations are completed **in the applicant's home country**, they must be **notarized by the Turkish Embassy or Consulate** in that country.
  - If translations are completed **within the Republic of Türkiye**, they must be **notarized by a Turkish notary office.**
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## 5. Required Documents for Application

All documents must be prepared in **Turkish** and uploaded during the online application.

Required documents include:

- High school diploma or temporary graduation certificate
  - High school transcript
  - Passport copy (identity and photo pages)
  - National or international exam results, if applicable (IB, Abitur, GCE, Tawjihi, SAT, YÖS, etc.) optional
  - Bank receipt confirming payment of the application fee
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## 6. Language of Instruction

Programs at Alanya University are offered with **100% English** or **100% Turkish** instruction, depending on the department.  
Preparatory language education is provided where required.

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## 7. English Proficiency & Preparatory Program

*(For English-Taught Programs)*

Students enrolling in programs where the **language of instruction is English** are required to attend the **English Preparatory Program**, unless they qualify for an exemption.

### English Preparatory School Exemptions

Students may be **exempt from the English Preparatory Program** if they meet **any** of the following conditions:

1. **Recognized English Proficiency Examinations**  
Submission of a valid national or international English proficiency certificate meeting the minimum requirements approved by the university.
2. **Graduation from an English-Medium High School in an English-Speaking Country**  
Students who have **completed their entire high school education at an English-medium school located in an English-speaking country**, together with the **citizens of that country**, may be exempted from the English Preparatory Program, provided that they submit **official documentation proving that the language of instruction was English**.

Applications of these students are **examined by the School of Foreign Languages (SFL) Directorate**.

Students found eligible are officially reported to the **Directorate of Student Affairs**.

Certificates must be **valid at the time of evaluation** and are assessed by the **School of Foreign Languages (SFL) Directorate**.

## English Preparatory Education & Assessment

Students who **do not meet exemption criteria** or who **fail the English Proficiency Examination** are required to attend **one year of intensive English Preparatory education**. At the end of the academic year, students **retake the proficiency examination**. Students who **successfully pass** may **register for and start their academic departments**.

## Maximum Duration Rule (English)

Students without a sufficient level of English knowledge are granted a maximum of *two academic years* to obtain the minimum English proficiency requirements. Failure to meet the required level within this period will result in **automatic cancellation of student registration**.

## 8. Turkish Language Proficiency (TÖMER)

*(For Turkish-Taught Programs)*

Students enrolling in programs where the **language of instruction is Turkish** must demonstrate Turkish language proficiency by either:

- Submitting a **Turkish Language Proficiency Certificate (TÖMER C1)** issued by official institutions or universities in Türkiye, or
- Successfully passing the **Turkish Proficiency Examination administered by Alanya University**.

Students who **successfully pass the Turkish Proficiency Examination conducted by Alanya University** are deemed to have fulfilled the Turkish language requirement and may **start their academic departments immediately**, without waiting for a separate TÖMER C1 certificate.

**Students without a TÖMER C1 certificate are granted a maximum of two academic years to obtain it.**

Failure to submit a valid Turkish proficiency document within this period will result in **automatic cancellation of registration**.

Students who have completed their **entire high school education at Turkish high schools**, either in Türkiye or abroad, are **exempt** from the Turkish language proficiency requirement.

## 9. Documents Required for Final Registration (On-Campus)

Students who arrive in Türkiye with an acceptance letter must complete **final registration in person** by submitting the following **original documents**:

- Original high school diploma (apostilled and officially translated into Turkish)
- Original high school transcript (officially translated into Turkish)
- Original passport (official Turkish translation required)
- Student visa (if applicable)
- Student residence permit or official proof of residence permit application
- Turkish language proficiency document (TÖMER C1 or Alanya University exam result), if applicable
- English language proficiency document, if applicable
- Valid health insurance covering the academic year in Türkiye
- Tuition fee payment receipt
- Biometric photographs 4.5\*6 2pcs
- Proof of sufficient financial means to continue higher education in Türkiye

Failure to submit **complete, original, and compliant documents** may prevent completion of final registration.

If a candidate fails to complete the registration process despite making the advance payment, the advance payment fee will not be refunded.

In order to receive the full acceptance letter to be able to proceed further with the final registration students are required to pay 1000 usd as an advance payment as part of their tuition fee according to the pre acceptance letter that they will be receiving fafter their application will be evaluated However, if the student's visa application is rejected and they provide documentation proving it to the University, the advance payment will be refunded with the deduction of the administrative fee of **200 USD**.

\*\*\*In the event of withdrawal from registration for a different reason, the advance payment fee will not be refunded.

## **Parental Consent Requirement (For Students Under 18)**

During the student residence permit application process, students under the age of 18 must submit:

A Letter of Consent signed by both parents, clearly stating that the student is authorized to:

- Reside in the Republic of Türkiye, and
- Pursue education independently without parental accompaniment.

This consent letter must be:

- Issued by the Turkish Consulate in the student's home country,
- or**
- Issued and notarized by a Turkish Notary Office within the Republic of Türkiye.

The document must be officially translated into Turkish (if issued in another language) and comply with apostille and notarization requirements where applicable.

Failure to provide a valid parental consent letter may result in delays or rejection of the residence permit application and may prevent completion of final registration.

Students are responsible for carefully reviewing the information and complying with all legal requirements upon arrival in Türkiye.

# **10. Tuition Fee Payment & Refund Policy**

## **1. Tuition Fee Structure**

The annual tuition fee consists of two instalments:

### **1st Instalment – Advance Payment (1,000 USD)**

- An advance payment of **1,000 USD** must be paid immediately after receiving the **Pre-Acceptance Letter**.
- This amount is part of the total annual tuition fee of the department in which the student has been conditionally accepted.
- The **Official Final Acceptance Letter** required for visa procedures will be issued only after this advance payment is received.

### **2nd Instalment – Remaining Tuition Fee**

- The remaining balance of the annual tuition fee must be paid **before the in-person registration process begins**.
- The full tuition fee must be **paid and finalized prior to submitting original documents for on-campus enrolment**.
- Registration will not be completed without confirmation of full payment.

## **2. Payment Confirmation Requirement**

- Payment receipts for **both instalments** must be sent in advance to the email address of the International Relations Office.
- Students must present original payment receipts during final registration if requested.
- Failure to provide proof of payment may delay or prevent completion of enrolment.

## **3. Refund Policy**

### **Visa Rejection**

If a student's visa application is officially rejected:

- The student must submit official written proof of visa rejection from the relevant Turkish Embassy or Consulate.
  - Upon verification, the **advance payment will be refunded**, with a deduction of **200 USD administrative fee**.
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### Withdrawal for Other Reasons

- In cases of voluntary withdrawal or failure to complete registration for reasons other than visa rejection, the **advance payment is non-refundable**.
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### Failure to Complete Registration

If a student:

- Does not arrive in Türkiye, or
- Fails to complete the registration process within the official deadlines

the advance payment will not be refunded.
