ISSUES RELATED TO THE APPLICATION

1. Applications for the Institute of Graduate Studies, 2025-2026 Academic Year Fall Semester will take place between 16 July 2025 - 01 September 2025. It will take place between dates. Prospective students can apply to graduate programs through the application link available at: https://sis.alanyauniversity.edu.tr/oibs/ina_app/
2. Graduates of our university or higher education institutions other than our university students' grade conversions are made based on the YÖK Grade Conversion Table <https://oyp.yok.gov.tr/Documents/Anasayfa/4lukSistem.pdf>
3. **Applications of candidates with missing or incorrect documents in the online application will be deemed invalid.**
4. A "Scientific Preparation Program", the scope and duration of which will be determined by the relevant department, may be mandatory for students who have not graduated from the related field.
5. Some documents such as Working Documents, CVs, Reference Letters, Portfolios, Theses, Equivalence or Recognition Certificates, etc., required by the special conditions of some programs must be uploaded to the additional document area of the online application system.

DOCUMENTS REQUIRED FOR APPLICATION

(FOR APPLICANTS WHO ARE CITIZENS OF THE REPUBLIC OF TURKEY)

The following documents must be scanned and uploaded to the system during the online application. Candidates must bring the originals of the documents uploaded to the system with them during the exam/interview.

1. **Diploma:** For master's degree applicants, a bachelor's degree diploma or graduation certificate. (You can also apply with a Temporary Graduation Certificate or a graduation certificate obtained from e-Government.)
2. **Transcript:** For master's degree applications, documents showing bachelor's courses and grades.
3. **ALES Certificate:** ALES exam result certificate. (This document is not required for applicants to non-thesis master's programs and international students)
4. **Foreign Language Certificate:** YDS or an equivalent exam result certificate. (This document is required for applicants to master's programs specified in the General Application Conditions.)
5. **Equivalence/Recognition Certificate:** Turkish citizens who have completed their education in foreign higher education institutions must upload an Equivalence Certificate or Recognition Certificate obtained from the Council of Higher Education to the application system. (Except for Turkish citizens graduating from universities in Northern Cyprus.)
6. **Photo:** 2 passport-sized photographs.
7. **ID Card Copy** (with original documents sworn translation offices or Turkish translation approved by Turkish Foreign Representatives for international students)

8. **Criminal Record Certificate** (Documents obtained from e-Government are accepted)
9. **Curriculum Vitae**
10. **Military Status Certificate for male candidates** (Documents obtained from e-Government are accepted.)

CRITERIA FOR APPLICATION AND ADMISSION OF INTERNATIONAL STUDENTS

The following documents must be scanned and uploaded to the system during the online application. Candidates must bring the originals of the documents uploaded to the system with them during the exam/interview.

1. **Diploma:** For master's degree applicants, a bachelor's degree diploma or graduation certificate. (You can also apply with a Temporary Graduation Certificate or a graduation certificate obtained from e-Government.) (with original documents sworn translation offices or Turkish translation approved by Turkish Foreign Representatives)
2. **Transcript:** For master's degree applications, documents showing bachelor's courses and grades (with original documents sworn translation offices or Turkish translation approved by Turkish Foreign Representatives)
3. **Document proving that you know Turkish (e.g. TÖMER...):** To enroll in graduate programs where the language of instruction is Turkish, foreign students are required to provide proof of their Turkish language proficiency. Foreign students who have graduated from a program taught in Turkish at a higher education institution in Turkey are exempt from the Turkish language requirement. Apart from this, to begin their graduate studies, candidates must hold a certificate demonstrating at least a B2 level of Turkish proficiency from language exams such as TÖMER, DİLMER, or TYS. At the request of the departments, this required score may be increased. Candidates of Turkish proficiency from exams such as TÖMER, DİLMER, or TYS who do not possess a certificate demonstrating at least the B2-level are required to take the Turkish proficiency exam administered by the university. Candidates who achieve the B2-level in this exam are accepted into the program and may begin their courses. Those who fail the exam are directed to Alanya University's Turkish preparatory program, which lasts for a maximum of two semesters, after which they must obtain a B2-level Turkish proficiency certificate. Foreign graduate student candidates who fail in Turkish language proficiency after this training will have their registrations canceled at the end of the year.
4. **General Health Insurance:** International students who have entered or will enter our country are required to have and document their General Health Insurance (GHI) at the time of registration at their university.
5. **Equivalence/Recognition Certificate:** Turkish citizens who have completed their education in foreign higher education institutions must upload an Equivalence Certificate or Recognition Certificate obtained from the Council of Higher Education to the application system (Except for Turkish citizens graduating from universities in Northern Cyprus). No equivalency certificate is required for the admission of foreign applicants to graduate programs. A school recognition certificate stating that the graduated undergraduate education

institution is recognized by the Higher Education Institution is sufficient. They can take the recognition certificate online from the Council of Higher Education at <https://okultanima.yok.gov.tr/>.

6. **Passport photocopy (The original documents along with their Turkish translations certified by a notary or Turkish foreign representatives).**
7. **Photo: 2 passport-size photos**
8. **Curriculum Vitae/CV (written in detail in Turkish or English)**

*Candidates may be asked to verify the information and documents submitted during the application process, or the University may investigate their accuracy. If any inconsistency is found in the information or documents, the candidate's admission to the program will be canceled, even if they have already been accepted!! The list of applicants whose applications are deemed eligible will be published on the official website of the Institute.

1. All results (primary/alternate, successful/unsuccessful candidates, etc.) will be announced through the application system in accordance with Law No. 6698 on the Protection of Personal Data. Additionally, the lists will not be publicly disclosed.
2. For Thesis Master's Programs, candidates up to five (5) times the quota will be invited for the written and/or interview exam.
3. Non-Thesis Master's Programs will not conduct exams (written and/or interview). Ranking will be determined by the application system based on graduation averages.
4. In accordance with the decision of the Council of Higher Education, the validity period of the ALES and YDS exams is five years.
5. As it is not permitted to enroll in more than one thesis-based master's program simultaneously, candidates who are accepted as students will not be enrolled in the Institute if they are registered in another higher education program at the same level. It is the responsibility of the student candidates to deregister from any previously enrolled higher education program.
